


# IRREGULAR

# BASE FORM >>> simple past

- Begin >>> began.
- Buy >>> bought.
- Catch >>> caught.
  - Fall >>> **fell**.
  - Fly >>> **flew**.
  - Run >>> **ran**.
  - Sleep >>> slept.
    - Tell>>> told.
    - Go>>> **went**.

# Regular verbs only. Spelling of "**-d**, **-ed**, **-ied**" form.

	SPELLING OF "-d", "-ed" and "-ied" FOR REGULAR VERBS.									
RULE	END OF VERB	EXAMPLE	RULE	FINAL FORM -ED						
1	A CONSONANT + e	smile / erase	add - "d"	smiled / erased						
2	ONE VOWEL + ONE CONSONANT	stop / rub	doble CTE + add - "ed"	stopped / rubbed						
2.1	ONE VOWEL + ONE CONSONANT	fix / snow	Do not doble consonant, only add -"ed"	fixed / snowed						
3	TWO VOWELS + ONE CONSONANT	rain / nee <mark>d</mark>	add - "ed"	rained / needed						
4	TWO CONSONANTS	cou <mark>nt</mark> / he <mark>lp</mark>	add - "ed"	counted / helped						
5	A CONSONANT + y	stu <mark>d</mark> y / car <mark>r</mark> y	change "y" to "i" + add - "ed"	studied / carried						
6	A VOWEL + y	play / enjoy	add - "ed"	played / enjoyed						



# Simple Past structure.



**I** played (play) You swam (swim) We danced (dance) They went (go) He arrived (arrive) She drove (drive) The knife (It) cut (cut)

- a) Regular verbs = -d -ed -ied(+)
- b) Irregular verbs = change (+)



(-) NEGATIVE (not)

(-) Auxiliary Negative: did not / didn't

did not play You didn't swim We didn't dance They did not go He did not arrive She didn't drive The knife (**It**) didn't cut

c) did + not = didn't



- Did I play ...?
- Did \*you swim ...?
- Did we dance ...?
- Did they go ...?
- Did he arrive ...?
- Did she drive ...?

Did the knife (**It**) cut ...? (+)



(+)Yes, I **did**. (-)No, I **didn´t**.

\*(+) Yes, I did. \*(-) No, I didn´t.

(+) Yes, we did.
(-) No, we didn't.

(+) Yes, they did.
(-) No, they didn't.

(+)Yes, he **did**. (-)No, he **didn´t**.

(+) Yes, she did.
(-) No, she didn't.

(+) Yes, it did.
(-) No, it didn't.

#### REMEMBER...

- Use past form of the <u>irregular</u> and <u>regular</u> verbs in affirmative form.
- Use *did not* or *didn´t* in negative form.
- To ask questions use auxiliary
   *Did* (I, you, we, they he, she, it)...
   ?

Not forget short answer (+) Yes, \_\_\_\_\_ did. (-) No, \_\_\_\_\_didn´t/did not. Robert wrote a letter five minutes ago. The **children did** their homework yesterday. Your **phone <u>rang</u> a minute ago**. I *did not* watch TV last night. Yesterday, the **kangaroo** *didn´t* jump. It was tierd. Did you feel dizzy last night ? "Yes, / did" She looked for her friends in the mall two hours ago. Did Susan read a book last night? Yes, she did. No, she didn't. Last night, they did not eat hotdogs. They ate pizza. The **dog bit** its new toys yesterday morning. Did | smile ? Yes, / did. No, / did not. They *did not* walk yesterday morning. It was cold. Where *did* Jack live last year? *He lived in Colorado.* I **swam** on the beach yesterday afternoon. **Did Janeth work** yesterday ? "**Yes**, she did". "**No**, she didn´t" What *did* you do last night ? (*your answer*)
